Sub: Registration of Additional Qualifications

- i. It is for information of all concerned that the qualifications which are duly recognized as per provisions of section 11(2) of Indian Medical Council (IMC) Act, duly notified by Government of India, are the only valid & recognized qualifications for being a faculty/specialist and purposes such as entry to secondary DNB seats.
- Masters in Emergency Medicine (MEM) qualification offered by any institution/overseas university is not a valid and recognized qualification for DNB Emergency Medicine Programme as on date.
- iii. Applicants are also advised to get their qualifications registered as additional qualifications under section 26 of IMC Act and appropriate rules & regulations thereafter with appropriate State Medical Council.
- iv. In case of foreign awarded qualifications from English speaking countries, the provisions as notified by Govt. of India shall apply. However, all qualifications have to be registered with appropriate State Medical Council or Medical Council of India.
