The Ministry vide Public Notice dated 22.08.2014 and the letter dated 10.12.2014 had declared the letter No. MCI-12(1)/2014-Med.Misc./101884 dated 09.04.2014 relating to the amendment in Teachers' Eligibility Qualification Regulations, 1988 void ab- initio. However, the Ministry is still receiving grievances from candidates regarding non-recognition of DNB degree by MCI approved medical colleges.
3. It is therefore requested to issue an advisory for the medical colleges to comply with the existing regulations regarding DNB qualifications.
