About the program: UNESCO approved 3T-IBHSC Bioethics Course has been designed to introduce medical, dental, nursing and health science teaching faculty of Universities and Colleges to teaching the modern Vertically Integrated Bioethics. Curriculum is based on 15 principles enshrined in the UNESCO's Universal Declaration on Bioethics and Human Rights.
